All Paddlers

- Take care of all property belonging to the club or club members
- Treat other club members with respect at all times, on and off the water
- Support and encourage fellow members and paddlers
- Listen to the advice and guidance provided by your coach
- Display positive behaviour and use appropriate language at all times
- Follow BCU and Herts Canoe Club Guidelines and Policies
- Recognise and acknowledge the good performance and improvement of others
- Ensure appropriate clothing, equipment and footwear is used for the conditions

Club Officials, Coaches and Volunteers, in addition to the above

- Consider the well being and safety of paddlers before the development of performance
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with paddlers, based on mutual trust and respect
- Ensure activities are appropriate to each individual and their level of ability
- Display high standards in behaviour, appearance and commitment
- Maintain coaching qualifications, training standards and insurance
